SPATIAL PLANNING

Renovated for a couple who loves to entertain, the home was reconfigured into an open-plan design with two guest bedrooms on one side of the house and an open master suite on the second floor. As you walk the main floor, you can't miss the colorful kitchen. It is safe to say that this kitchen is the center of attention and a conversation piece at every party. The entire second floor of the house, accessed by stairs or elevator, was renovated into an open-plan master suite.

CREATIVE INSPIRATION

Unconventional and unique design elements reflect the client's love of color. White marble floors and off-white walls create a backdrop for unique design features and a creative use of color. One-of-a-kind elements were used in every detail of this project. These elements are particularly dominant in the living room, powder room, kitchen and the master bathroom. Even furnishings are sculptural statements in exotic wood veneers and the client's colorful accessories are cleverly incorporated into the mix.

DESIGN INNOVATION

Unusual elements were custom designed. The home is also very efficient, featuring a special filtration system and water-harvesting capabilities that allow for water recirculation, and energy-efficient LED lighting further enhances the beauty of this home with minimum energy consumption.
